Building charges for a facility are exempt for 1st and 2nd priority groups, or as determined by the Parks and Recreation Board.

Fees pertain to the building/shelter area only. Groups exceeding 100 may be subject to the prevailing cost towards additional portable toilets.

Athletic fields require separate reservation, except as noted for Bluhm Park and Denoon Park.

Keys for facilities, if applicable, must be picked up at the Parks and Recreation Department office the day prior to use; in the case of a weekend or Monday, the Friday before. Keys must be picked up by 3:30 p.m. A \$25 security deposit is required when the key is obtained. This must be a separate check from the usage fee payment. Security deposits will be returned after the area has been inspected and approved by the Parks Supervisor. Keys are due in the Parks and Recreation Department the day following use, except in the case of a Friday through Sunday use, when they must be returned on Monday before 3:30 p.m. Security deposits will be mailed within three days of use.

Rental of Bluhm Park shelter includes the Bluhm I athletic field.

Music (if planned) to be turned off by 9:00 p.m. and permission must be obtained from the Parks and Recreation Board.

Any building, tent, or structure in addition to the outdoor shelter on premises must have permission from the Parks and Recreation Board.

Idle Isle shelter is not available Friday-Sunday, Holidays and Special Events for rental between Memorial Day to Labor Day as determined by the Parks and Recreation Board.
