RULES & REGULATIONS FOR USE OF TENNIS COURTS

The tennis courts located within Muskego City Parks are available for general public use Monday through Sunday during park hours (5:00 a.m.-Dusk) unless a lesson program sponsored by the Parks and Recreation Department is taking place on the courts. A full listing of lessons/leagues can be found in the Summer Program Guide. Use of the Muskego High School Tennis Courts is now ran through the district.

We ask that you observe the following rules:

- If players are waiting to use the court, a time limit must be observed: one hour for a singles match; one and one-half hours for a doubles match.
- Courts are used on a first-come, first-served basis, except during Parks and Recreation Department organized use.
- It is the goal of the Parks and Recreation Department to have at least one court "open" at a city park during our evening lesson schedule.
- Adults have priority over children under the age of 15 on week nights after 5:00 p.m. during the months of June, July and August.
- Tennis shoes only are allowed on the courts.
- Use of bad language will not be tolerated. Remember, a good tennis player is always a courteous one.
- No alcoholic beverages or smoking is allowed on the city courts.
- Bicycles and motor vehicles are not permitted on the courts.
