### **Fireworks Permit**

A permit is required for an individual to display fireworks. Individual applicant must be an owner and resident of real property in the City of Muskego. All fireworks applications must be submitted to the Clerk's Office between May 1 and June 30. These permits are for the individual use of fireworks at the location listed, only on the specific display date applied for (July 3 through July 5 only) during the hours of 4:00 pm and 11:00 pm. A separate application must be submitted for each date requested.

### **Green Up Muskego**

Starting May 1, 2017 officers will begin the City enforcement of junked/non-operable vehicles found in residential settings. Information is available on the city web site under ordinance number 10.05(16).
