CORRECTED FIREWORKS DISPLAY

An individual user fireworks discharge permit application may be made by any owner and resident of real property in the City of Muskego, for intended discharge on such applicant's property. Such application may be made pursuant to Section 167.10(3)(c), Wisconsin Statutes, and shall be subject to all applicable terms of this Section 9.03. Such use is restricted to the following dates: 5 July 3, 4 or 5 each year, subject to the following. **If the 4th of July falls on a Monday or Tuesday, the Saturday before will be allowed. If the 4th of July falls on a Wednesday or Thursday, the Saturday after will be allowed.**
