Fireworks Permit

A permit is required for an individual to display fireworks. Individual applicant must be an owner and resident of real property in the City of Muskego. All fireworks applications must be submitted to the Clerk's Office between May 1 and June 30. These permits are for the individual use of fireworks at the location listed, only on the specific display date applied for (July 3 through July 5 only) during the hours of 4:00 pm and 11:00 pm. A separate application must be submitted for each date requested.

Don't become a victim!

On April 23, 2016 a resident received a telephone call from "Card Holders Services", promising to help them consolidate their credit card debt into one easy payment. After providing personal information, including their credit card numbers, the caller quickly hung up the phone. Officers advised the resident that the call was a scam, and since personal information was provided, to contact their credit card company and cancel the cards. Remember, do not provide any personal information to anyone over the telephone, unless you either made the call, or have verified that the person on the other end of the phone is legitimately from your credit card company.
