All fireworks applications must be submitted to the Clerk's Office between May 1 and June 30. These permits are for the individual use of fireworks at the location listed, only on the specific display date applied for (July 3 through July 5 only) during the hours of 4:00 pm and 11:00 pm. A separate application must be submitted for each date requested.

***** For Immediate Release *****

On Monday, 05/02/16, at approximately 11:35am, the City of Muskego Police Department received several 911 calls reporting a house fire at S82 W13115 Acker Drive. The Tess Corners Fire Department, along with officers from Muskego Police Department responded to the single family residence which was fully engulfed in flames. Mutual aid was requested from the Village of Hales Corners, Village of Big Bend and the Town of Vernon Fire Departments and the fire was contained within approximately 1 hour. The residents were not home at the time of the fire. The Muskego Police Department, along with the Division of Criminal Investigation Deputy State Fire Marshal, is investigating the cause of the fire.

The fire was determined to likely be the result of arson. Through the course of the investigation it was determined the home owner's estranged husband; James F. Barbian, is a suspect and his whereabouts are unknown at this time. It is believed that Barbian is operating a maroon, 2005 Chevrolet Equinox with Wisconsin registration plates 480-MUG.

A criminal complaint and arrest warrant for James F. Barbian has been filed by the Waukesha County District Attorney's Office for Arson; Burglary; and two counts of Mistreatment of Animals/Cause Death.

The investigation is ongoing.
