ARSON SUSPECT IN CUSTODY

During the early morning hours on Friday, 05/27/16, arson suspect, James F. Barbian was located and taken into custody without incident.

While on routine patrol, an officer from the City of Franklin Police Department located Barbian's 2005 Chevrolet Equinox at the Sunset Motel on South 27th Street. Once taken into custody by officers from the Franklin Police Department, Barbian was turned over to the City of Muskego Police Department, and subsequently transported to the Waukesha County Jail.

James F. Barbian is being charged by the Waukesha County District Attorney's Office for Arson; Burglary; and two counts of Mistreatment of Animals/Cause Death.
