School is Open Again

It is that time of the year again, kids are standing alongside the roadway waiting for their school bus. Please be careful, and remember:

Rules for Stopping for a Stopped School Bus displaying red warning lights ss# 346.48:

Operator of a vehicle which approaches from the front or rear of any school bus, which has stopped on a street or highway when it is displaying flashing red warning lights, shall stop their vehicle not less than 20 feet from the bus and shall remain stopped until the bus resumes motion or the operator extinguishes the red flashing warning lights.

Wisconsin state statute 346.485, directs law enforcement to issue a citation to the registered owner of a vehicle witnessed to illegally passing a school bus.

The statute doesn't apply to the operators of vehicles proceeding in the opposite direction on a divided highway.

Fines for illegal passing of school bus violations:

Illegally passing a stopped school bus—\$250.00, and 4 points

Owners liability on an illegally passing of a school bus is also \$250.00, and 0 points.
