### **Continued Thefts**

The Muskego Police Department continues to receive theft complaints around Little Muskego Lake of batteries being removed from boats. We ask that you attempt to secure your batteries the best that you can, and to report any suspicious activity that you observe. We also recommend that you mark the battery with your name or some other identifying mark and photograph the battery in case it is stolen.

### **Help Protect Yourself**

The Muskego Police Department recommends that you take photographs of your jewelry, electronics or any other item of value. During most of our investigations, homeowners do not have much information for us to assist in our investigation. Having photographs and accurate descriptions of these items greatly assist us when we locate items and try to determine the owner. Having this information will also assist in filing insurance claims. And remember to store the photographs somewhere other than your computer, which if stolen, will not assist in the investigation. Put them on a thumb drive or burn them to a CD and keep it somewhere safe away from the home.
