The telephone number showing up on caller ID is our telephone number. They are actually using the name of our detective, claiming that bail money is required for a family member to get out of jail. To our knowledge no money has been exchanged to this point, but we remind you to be very cautious. With all the new technologies and ability to “pick your number” or alter caller ID units, criminals are starting to prey on victims in different ways.
