Armed Robbery Suspect Arrested and Charged

Muskego Police officers, acting on an anonymous tip, executed search warrants in Franklin and Muskego on Wednesday, December 30, 2015, and took a Muskego man into custody in connection with an Armed Robbery which took place at the Loomis Petro Mart, S107 W16311 Loomis Road, on Tuesday, December 22, 2015.

27 year old Donald L Counter was arrested and charged with Armed Robbery in Waukesha County Circuit on Monday, January 4, 2016. The Muskego Police Department is continuing to work to identify two other suspects in this Armed Robbery. Anyone with information regarding the identity of the two suspects is urged to contact the Muskego Police Department at 262-679-4130. They may remain anonymous, and may be eligible for a reward of up to \$1,000.00 offered by CrimeStoppers of Waukesha County.

Occupants of Fleeing Vehicle Identified

On Tuesday, December 22, 2015, at approximately 2:41am, a Muskego Police officer conducted a traffic stop of a vehicle which later turned out to be stolen. After initially stopping and speaking with the officer, the driver and passenger fled the scene of the stop in the vehicle. The vehicle was later disabled by Stop Sticks deployed by another Muskego Officer. The occupants of the vehicle then fled on foot and avoided capture.

Investigation has identified the driver of the stolen vehicle as 21 year old DARRIUS K JOHNSON. The passenger was identified as 21 year old SHAQUILLE U. WILLIAMS. Both men are from Milwaukee.

A warrant for Johnson's arrest was issued through Wisconsin Department of Correction. Charges against both Johnson and Williams have been referred to the Waukesha County District Attorney's office, and an additional arrest warrant was issued for Johnson in connection with this investigation. Charges against Johnson include Fleeing/Eluding an Officer, Operating without Owner's Consent, Resisting/Obstructing an Officer and Operating after Suspension. Charges of Resisting/Obstructing an Officer were referred for Williams. Johnson also faces a variety of municipal traffic charges. Reward Offered

On Thursday, 12/24/15, the homeowners at W140 S9095 Boxhorn Dr, Muskego WI, 53150 called the Muskego Police Department to report a burglary to their residence. The burglary occurred between 12/19/15 and 12/24/15. A small Sentry brand safe measuring 2' x 2' x 6" was removed from the residence. The safe contained currency, jewelry, prescription medications, and keys.
