Greetings from your neighbors at the Muskego Police Department,

We took a week off but we're back, and here is what we've been doing:

- January 23, 2015; 11:28pm – Officers checking on a vehicle in Denoon Park after hours ended up arresting a Waukesha man and two Waterford men, all 17 years old, for possession of drugs and paraphernalia.

- January 27, 2015; 3:00pm – Walmart reported stopping a woman in their store who was concealing merchandise. She dropped the items and fled. She was recognized as a suspect in two other thefts. She has been identified as a 30 year old Milwaukee woman. The investigation is continuing.
- January 27, 2015; 4:03pm – A 43 year old Greenfield woman was arrested for an outstanding warrant, and was cited for driver's license and registration violations after a traffic stop on Moorland Rd. at College Ave.
