Crowbar Rd Detour

The Wisconsin DOT will be performing some construction on the Crowbar Rd bridge over I-43. The project is scheduled to begin July, and will take four months to complete ending in October. The entire bridge will be closed. Traffic from the north side will be detoured west to HWY 164, south to Janesville Rd then back to Crowbar Rd. North bound traffic will be detoured in the opposite direction.
