Uber / Lyft

If you drive for any kind of service similar to these, be aware that your vehicle insurance may not cover you if you file a claim while you are "on duty". Most major insurance companies have started to classify drivers as a "commercial" status, which is a complete and different insurance classification. Acuity has changes their policy to read "Acuity will not provide coverage if a loss occurs while you are participating in a personal vehicle sharing program in which your vehicle is rented out to another private individual for a fee". Protect yourself and check with your agent.

Fireworks Permit

An individual user fireworks discharge permit application may be made by any owner and resident of real property in the City of Muskego, for intended discharge on such applicant's property. Such application may be made pursuant to Section 167.10(3)(c), Wisconsin Statutes, and shall be subject to all applicable terms of this Section 9.03. Such use is restricted to the following dates: July 3, 4 or 5 each year, subject to the following. If the 4th of July falls on a Monday or Tuesday, the Saturday before will be allowed. If the 4th of July falls on a Wednesday or Thursday, the Saturday after will be allowed. The application must specify the name and address of the requested permit holder, the date on and after which fireworks may be purchased, the general kind and approximate quantity of fireworks which may be purchased, the date and location of the proposed use, and the name, address and telephone number for the individual responsible for the discharge of fireworks. A separate application must be submitted for each day use is intended. All permit applications under this subsection must be filed between May 1 and June 30, unless earlier submission is required to allow for Public Safety Committee review pursuant to Section 9.03(3)(d)(7) Until next time, have a good week, stay alert and stay safe.
