The registration form asks for detailed information on ways to communicate/interact with special needs residents, any medical needs that we need to be aware of during an emergency, who we should contact on behalf of the individual, and other vital information. We also have an M-SNAP Silver program, which is designed to assist with elderly residents, especially those that tend to walk away from the home. Both programs offer the ability to attach a photograph, which we put in to our computer system, allowing the officers on the road to see the photo during a neighborhood search.
