Sorry for the delay, Muskego! The flu hit me Friday morning like a Mack truck carrying a full load of cement and the driver was running behind schedule. Now that I can breathe out of at least one nostril and my stomach isn't treating everything I eat like it's covered in ipecac syrup, I'll get you last week's events!

April 18th:

- 1:32 a.m. – A 23 year old Union Grove resident was cited for operating a motor vehicle with a suspended driver's license (OAS) near the intersection of STH 36 and Muskego Dam Dr.
- 8:09 a.m. – Officers responded to a business located in the S6600 block of Commerce Dr. per the request of Milwaukee Police Department, in an attempt to make contact with a subject wanted for a probation violation. A 41 year old Milwaukee resident was arrested for the probation violation, as well as a warrant he held through the Department of Community Corrections.
