My own fault, but at least I'm done spreading mulch. I was planning on releasing this edition of the newsletter last Friday, the 21st, until I remembered I'd be away from my desk all day at training (apologies). So, here it is!

June 7th:

- 12:20 a.m. – A 23 year old resident of the W17300 block of Joel Dr. was arrested for possession of a controlled substance and drug paraphernalia following a traffic stop that occurred near the intersection of Durham Dr. and Priegel Dr.
- 10:55 a.m. – A 71 year old Franklin resident called the police department to report a large amount of grass clippings in the roadway near the intersection of Woods Rd. and Racine Ave. Contact was made with the negligent spreader of said grass clippings, a 64 year old resident of the W17900 block of Woods Rd. who was advised of the complaint.
- 4:36 p.m. – A 19 year old West Allis resident responded to the police department to report that her wallet was stolen at her place of employment, a business located in the W15800 block of Aud Mar Dr. Investigation is continuing.
- 6:56 p.m. – A 37 year old resident of the S8200 block of Pioneer Dr. was cited for parking too close to another vehicle parked in a handicap parking stall. The violation occurred in the parking lot of a business located in the W17000 block of Janesville Rd.

Two subjects were transported to area hospitals, where one of the subjects was later pronounced dead. The vehicle suspected of causing the fatal accident has yet to be located/identified. June 8th:

- 7:50 a.m. – A U/I complainant called the police department to report a construction crew had begun working approximately one hour prior to calling, which is about 2 hours earlier than they are allowed to on Saturdays (9 a.m.). Officers made contact with the crew and advised them of the ordinance. It's 7 a.m. during the week and 10 a.m. on Sundays. Now you all know!
- 9:15 a.m. – A 40 year old Sussex resident and a 66 year old New Berlin resident were cited for parking violations at Idle Isle.
- 12:01 p.m. – A 40 year old Greenfield resident called the police department to report the plumber working at his new residence under construction near Oakridge Lane and Martin Dr. had removed
