Special Voting Deputies appointed by the City of Muskego will not be administering absentee voting to residents of the facilities named above for the **April 6, 2021 Spring Election** due to COVID visitor restrictions. Since Special Voting Deputies will not be permitted entry to the facilities, tele-visits have been scheduled during the dates & times indicated above. Absentee ballots will be delivered to the facilities once the tele-visits have been completed.

Only observers from each of the two recognized political parties whose candidates for governor or president received the greatest number of votes in the municipality at the most recent general election may accompany the deputies during tele-visits. Each party wishing to have an observer present shall submit the name of the observer to the clerk or board of election commissioners no later than the close of business on the last business day prior to the visit.
